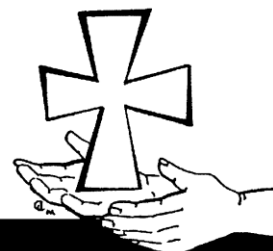

We welcome back old friends who have been meditating with us for a while – and we look forward to meeting newcomers who might be thinking of joining us at this time of “new normalcy”. Remember to bring your mask with you. No one will be admitted without a mask. I’ll be happy to see all of you.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Since my letter on June 8, 2020, a lot has changed. First of all we are now able to distribute Communion! Distribution of Communion takes place after the final blessing. We have done this over the past couple of weeks. It has taken some time to tweak the procedure and changing the flow of movement. It is thought that upon reaching phase IV, we will be able to go up to 33% capacity (about 148 people in the Parish Center). Only once in the past two weeks did we come close to capacity. So as we slowly are able to restart, there have been some concerns, one is social distancing, and we have addressed that with better markings on the floor and by using ushers/Eucharistic ministers to help guide people during communion. We have also for the time being eliminated ushers going around with baskets. There are stations at the main entrance of the hall and on the stage for people to put their offering in either before or after Mass. Another option is to sign up for Faith Direct, which our online giving platform, <https://membership.faithdirect.net/enroll/66>. Likewise, we have the opportunity of Text to Give. Text keyword **162parishimmaculate** to (516) 271-3338. *You will then be able to pay with a credit card.* With these ways of giving, you are able to make your offering without having to interact with our collection stations.

As we slowly start back up, we will need your cooperation and the cooperation of all the faithful. All who wish to go to Mass **MUST WEAR MASK/FACE COVERING**, the only exception is for those under 2 years of age. You will not be admitted to any of the buildings, Church or Parish Center without mask/face covering. You must wear mask/face covering for the duration of the Mass. It should cover your nose and mouth. This is for the protection of everyone. Sunday Mass Schedule will be 5pm on Saturday, 8am, 10am, and 12noon on Sunday in English in the Parish Center. This will enable us to disinfect the Parish Center and Church after every Mass. If the Parish Center reaches capacity, we will have a second Mass in the Church as overflow. The obligation to go to Sunday Mass is still lifted. If you are sick or in a vulnerable category, we ask you to remain home for your health and safety and the health and safety of everyone. 8am Daily Masses (Monday-Friday) will be in the Church. Confession is available on Saturday 4-4:45pm and by appointment.

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Desde mi carta del 8 de junio de 2020, muchas cosas han cambiado. En primer lugar, ¡ahora podemos distribuir Comunión! La distribución de la comunión se lleva a cabo después de la bendición final. Lo hemos hecho en las últimas dos semanas. Ha tomado algún tiempo modificar el procedimiento y cambiar el flujo del movimiento. Se cree que al llegar a la fase IV, podremos subir al 33% de la capacidad (alrededor de 148 personas en el Centro Parroquial). Solo una vez en las últimas dos semanas nos acercamos a la capacidad. Entonces, a medida que lentamente podemos reiniciar, ha habido algunas preocupaciones, una es el distanciamiento social, y hemos abordado eso con mejores marcas en el piso y utilizando ujieres / ministros eucarísticos para ayudar a guiar a las personas durante la comunión. Por el momento, también hemos eliminado a los ujieres que andan con canastas. Hay estaciones en la entrada principal del salón y en el escenario para que las personas presenten su ofrenda antes o después de la misa. Otra opción es inscribirse en Faith Direct, que nuestra plataforma de donaciones en línea, <https://membership.faithdirect.net/enroll/66>. Del mismo modo, tenemos la oportunidad de Text to Give. La palabra clave de texto 162parishimmaculate a (516) 271-3338. Luego podrá pagar con tarjeta de crédito. Con estas formas de donación, puede hacer su oferta sin tener que interactuar con nuestras estaciones de recolección.

A medida que comenzamos a retroceder lentamente, necesitaremos su cooperación y la cooperación de todos los fieles. Todos los que deseen asistir a Misa DEBEN USAR MÁSCARA / CUBIERTA DE CARA, la única excepción es para los menores de 2 años. No será admitido en ninguno de los edificios, la Iglesia o el Centro Parroquial sin máscara / cubierta de cara. Debe usar una máscara / cubierta facial durante la Misa. Debe cubrirse la nariz y la boca. Esto es para la protección de todos. El horario de misas dominicales será a las 5pm los sábados, a las 8am, 10am, 12mediodía en inglés y a las 5pm en español en el centro parroquial. Esto nos permitirá desinfectar el Centro Parroquial y la Iglesia después de cada Misa. La obligación de ir a la misa dominical todavía se levanta. Si está enfermo o en una categoría vulnerable, le pedimos que permanezca en casa por su salud y seguridad y la salud y seguridad de todos. Las 8am Misas diarias (de lunes a viernes) estarán en la Iglesia. La confesión está disponible los sábados 4-4: 45pm y con cita previa.

Gracias por su paciencia y cooperación.
