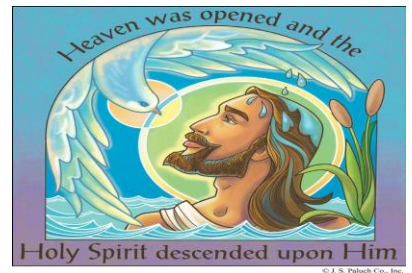

Jesus is baptized in the Jordan River by his cousin, John. It is in baptism that we are united with the Church to be sent on a mission to become disciples.

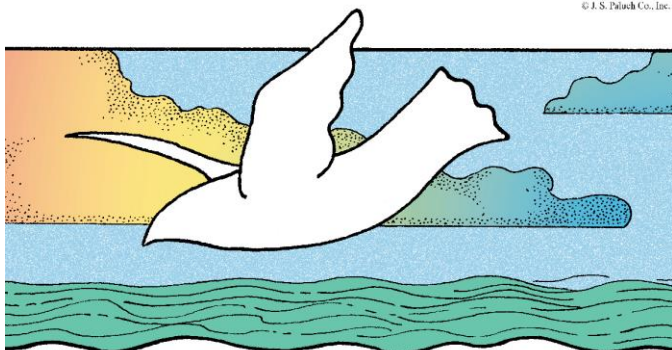
