TODAY'S READINGS

Malachi 3:19-20a: Lo, the sun of justice will rise!
Psalm 98: "The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice."

2 Thessalonians 3:7-12: Instead of keeping busy, some are minding the business of others.

Luke 21:5-19: When will the end of the world arrive?

Malachi sets the mood for today's readings in a matter of seconds, warning that the day of judgment is coming, when the world will be reduced to stubble and God will show no mercy to the wicked. Paul reproves those in the Christian community in Thessalonika who have given up and grown lazy and disorderly. Jesus warns the people gathered in the temple that the day will come when all they see around them will be destroyed, but that God will protect those who persevere in the faith. Let us pray that we can truly welcome that day when God comes to rule the earth with justice.
